The Jordanian Geologists Association is honored to invite you to participate in the *11th International Conference of the Jordanian Geologists Association* and the *10th International Symposium on Eastern Mediterranean Geology*. The conference has been designed to set up a forum to promote discussions on Earth and Environmental Sciences in the region. Contributions to the scientific program are invited.

Forward

This conference is a special occasion for all geoscientists to present their outstanding scientific contributions. The conference will focus on geosciences issues relevant to our special location at the triple junction of Europe, Asia and Africa. Therefore, it is important to encourage an international approach and sharing of knowledge from all over the world at this special conference, in Amman, to exchange and update our knowledge and science.

Venue

Jordan is a country of culture, beauty and surprising contrasts. It is an ancient land, yet a modern Kingdom, offering the discerning traveler fascinating diversity, safety and traditional hospitality. The unique geology, geography and climate make Jordan a perfect place for the conference.

Amman, the capital of Jordan is a busy commercial and administrative center with many fine hotels, restaurants, art galleries and museums. Amman is crowned by the Citadel, a hill with the ruins of the Temple of Hercules, a Byzantine Church and an Omayyad Palace. At the foot of the Citadel lies the Roman Theatre.

Abstracts

An abstract volume will be compiled and distributed at the conference. Abstracts must be submitted via e-mail in the form *MS Word in Arial 12 font*. Abstracts must be in English and are limited to 300 words. No line drawings or electronic art work will be accepted. Abstracts will be evaluated, and a notification of acceptance will be e-mailed to the corresponding author as soon as the abstracts have been considered.

Language

The official language of the conference will be English. No simultaneous translation will be available.

Presentation Options

• Oral

Oral presentation sessions will be grouped according to topics. Oral presentations are limited to 20 minutes, including discussion.

• Poster

A special hall for poster presentations will be available with individual standing boards. Posters format should be with **A0** dimensions and portrait layout. Participants need to bring their posters printed as no poster printers will be available at the conference.

Visual Aids

Visual aids will include laptop facilities. Speakers are encouraged to prepare data and make presentations using Microsoft Power Point Software. You will not be able to use your own computer.

Exhibition

The conference offers unique opportunities for private sector organizations, governmental agencies and academic institutions to display their products, services, new technologies and progress in their research.

Field Trip

There will be one post-conference field trip (a minimum of 15 participants is required for the trip to be run).

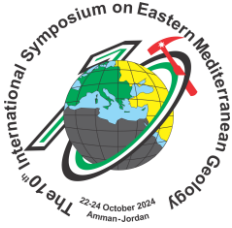
